**AN ORDINANCE RENAMING A TOWN ROAD:
Former Name: USH 51
NEW NAME: NORTH TOWNE ROAD**

Town of Windsor Ordinance 2014-04 was duly considered and adopted by the Town of Windsor Town Board pursuant to a vote of 5 in favor and 0 against at a duly noticed public meeting held on June 19, 2014, at the Windsor Town Hall, Town of Windsor, Dane County, State of Wisconsin.

Description:

A portion of reconstructed road formerly known as USH 51 and now under the jurisdiction of the Town of Windsor. Following reconstruction of USH 51, this Town Road runs parallel and to the west of the reconstructed USH 51. The Town Road has been renamed to North Towne Road, in the Town of Windsor.

**TOWN OF WINDSOR
ORDINANCE NO. 2014-04**

**AN ORDINANCE RENAMING A PORTION OF
OLD HIGHWAY 51 TO NORTH TOWNE ROAD**

WHEREAS, Wis. Stats. § 60.23(17) authorizes a town board to name and change street names pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 82.03(7), which states:

(7) HIGHWAY NAMES. The town board shall, by ordinance, assign a name to each of the roads that are under the town's jurisdiction. No road name may be used on more than one road within the jurisdiction of the town.

; and

WHEREAS, the Windsor Town Board finds that the jurisdiction of that portion of Old U.S. Highway 51 north of Windsor Road and depicted on the map attached as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference has transferred to the Town of Windsor; and

WHEREAS, Town staff has had contact with persons and businesses who will be affected by a change in the name of the Town Road, and recommends that the change in the name to North Towne Road be effective on July 1, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Town has an official map as described in Article III of Chapter 38 of the Town's Code of Ordinances and recommends that this change in name and location of Old U.S. Highway 51 be depicted thereon at such time as the official map is updated (*see* Windsor Town Ordinance § 38-53); and

WHEREAS, following consideration of relevant factors, the Windsor Town Board finds that changing the name of the road to North Towne Road is appropriate and wishes to amend its ordinances to reflect the findings made herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Windsor, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

1. **Change in Name to North Towne Road.** The name of the portion of Old U.S. Highway 51 north of Windsor Road, as depicted on the attached Exhibit A, shall be changed to North Towne Road.
2. **Notification.** The Town staff shall take such actions as are necessary and prudent to notify persons and businesses located thereon as well as emergency services providers, the property tax lister and relevant taxing authorities and the town sanitary district of this change in name to North Towne Road.
3. **Update to Official Map.** At such time as the Town updates its official map, this change shall be reviewed and included in accordance with the procedure set forth in Windsor Town Ordinance § 38-53.

4. **Delayed Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law, and shall have a delayed effective date of July 1, 2014.

The above and foregoing Ordinance was duly adopted at a regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Windsor on the 19th day of June, 2014.


