

ORDINANCE 2014-07

ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 36-2(b) OF THE WINDSOR MUNICIPAL CODE TO PROHIBIT THE UNLAWFUL USE OF COMPUTERIZED COMMUNICATION SYSTEMS

WHEREAS, the Town Board is authorized to prohibit conduct in the Town of Windsor that is also prohibited under chapters 941 to 948 of the Wisconsin Statutes; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Board deems it in the public interest to prohibit the unlawful use of computerized communication systems in order to protect the public health, safety, benefit and welfare of residents of and visitors to, the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Windsor, Dane County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

1. Section 36-2(b) of the Town of Windsor Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to add the following State Statute as incorporated into the Code:


947.0125 Unlawful Use of Computerized Communication Systems


2. All other provisions of § 36-2(b) of the Code remain in effect.


