AN ORDINANCE RENAMING A TOWN ROAD:
Former Names: Grinde Road / Windsor Way /
Old County Highway V (all east of USH 51)
NEW NAME: SNOWY OWL COURT

Town of Windsor Ordinance 2014-08 was duly considered and adopted by the Town of Windsor Town Board pursuant to a vote of 5 in favor and 0 against at a duly noticed public meeting held on September 18, 2014, at the Windsor Town Hall, Town of Windsor, Dane County, State of Wisconsin.

Description:

A portion of Town Road formerly known as Grinde Road (east of USH 51) and Windsor Way. Following reconstruction of USH 51, this Town Road is a cul-de-sac east of USH 51 and runs east to the intersection with County Highway V. The Town Road has been renamed to Snowy Owl Court, in the Town of Windsor.

**TOWN OF WINDSOR
ORDINANCE NO. 2014-08**

**AN ORDINANCE RENAMING A TOWN ROAD:
Grinde Road/Windsor Way/Old County Highway V (east of USH 51)
TO SNOWY OWL COURT**

WHEREAS, Wis. Stats. § 60.23(17) authorizes a town board to name and change street names pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 82.03(7), which states:

(7) HIGHWAY NAMES. The town board shall, by ordinance, assign a name to each of the roads that are under the town's jurisdiction. No road name may be used on more than one road within the jurisdiction of the town.

; and

WHEREAS, the Windsor Town Board finds that the Town has jurisdiction of that portion of Old County Highway V that is east of USH 51 beginning at an intersection where Grinde Road is west of USH 51 and Old County Highway V is east of USH 51,¹ and continuing to the current County Highway V (hereafter, "remnant of Old CTH V"), all as depicted on the map attached as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Town Ordinance 2012-01, the Town requested that the remnant of Old CTH V be renamed as "Windsor Way;" and

WHEREAS, for a number of reasons including public safety, Dane County will not allow additional roads in the County to include the name "Windsor" and has requested that the Town rename the road named "Windsor Way;" and

WHEREAS, the Town staff has considered the options, and recommends that the name of the remnant of Old CTH V be changed to Snowy Owl Court, effective on October 1, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Town has an official map as described in Article III of Chapter 38 of the Town's Code of Ordinances and recommends that this change in name of the remnant of Old CTH V be depicted as Snowy Owl Court thereon at such time as the official map is updated (*see* Windsor Town Ordinance §§ 38-52 and 53); and

WHEREAS, following consideration of relevant factors, the Windsor Town Board finds that changing the name of the road to Snowy Owl Court is appropriate and wishes to amend its ordinances to reflect the findings made herein.

¹ The intersection described is just north of the old at-grade USH 51 intersection with County Highway V west of USH 51 and Mueller Road east of USH 51. The Old County Highway V followed USH 51 and then turned east at the next intersection north (the old USH 51/Grinde/CTH V intersection), but now continues east of USH 51 under the new USH 51 bridge and connects with CTH V east of USH 51, thereby creating this remnant. See attached map.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Windsor, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

1. **Change in Name to Snowy Owl Court.** The name of the remnant of Old CTH V, as depicted on the attached Exhibit A, shall be and hereby is changed to Snowy Owl Court. Town Ordinance 2012-01 is null and void and of no further effect.
2. **Notification.** The Town staff shall take such actions as are necessary and prudent to notify persons and businesses located thereon as well as emergency services providers, the property tax lister and relevant taxing authorities and the town sanitary district of this change in name to Snowy Owl Court.
3. **Update to Official Map.** At such time as the Town updates its official map, this change shall be reviewed and included in accordance with the procedure set forth in Windsor Town Ordinances §§ 38-52 and 53. In the interim, this Ordinance No. 2014-08 shall be recorded at the Dane County Register of Deeds office, with the tax parcels and legal description as prepared by the Town Planning and Development Coordinator with assistance from the Town Attorney, as necessary.
4. **Delayed Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law, and shall have a delayed effective date of October 1, 2014.

The above and foregoing Ordinance was duly adopted at a regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Windsor on the 18th day of September, 2014.






