

ORDINANCE 2015-05

ORDINANCE REGARDING ANIMALS RUNNING AT LARGE

The Board of Supervisors of the Town of Windsor, Dane County, Wisconsin, do hereby ordain as follows:

1. Ordinance 8-1 (1) Definitions is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

(1) At large. To be off the premises of the owner and not under the control of some person by leash, but a dog or cat within an automobile of its owner, or in an automobile of any other person with the consent of the owner of said dog or cat shall be deemed to be upon the owner's premises.

2. Ordinance 8-24 (b) Animals Running at Large is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:


(b) A dog shall not be considered to be running at large if it is on a leash and under control of a handler who is in fact controlling the dog.


3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.






