AMENDMENT OF ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING BOARD OF REVIEW IN CHAPTER 2,  
SEC. 2-171 OF THE WINDSOR CODE OF ORDINANCES

THE VILLAGE BOARD FOR THE VILLAGE OF WINDSOR, LOCATED IN DANE COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


**SECTION ONE:** Chapter 2 of the Windsor Code of Ordinances establishes the Administration of the Village of Windsor. Section 2-171 of Chapter 2 establishes the Board of Review required by Wis. Stat. sec. 70.47. Now that Windsor is a Village, it is prudent to amend Sec. 2-171, all as set forth in Exhibit A, which is attached and incorporated by reference. The attached Sec. 2-171 is hereby adopted to replace the previous Sec. 2-171, and shall be included in the Windsor Code of Ordinances.


**SECTION TWO:** Sec. 2-171 shall become effective following its adoption by the Village Board and publication or posting in the manner required by law.





**CHAPTER 2 - ADMINISTRATION**

**ARTICLE IV. - BOARDS, COMMISSIONS, AUTHORITIES AND  
COMMITTEES**

**DIVISION 2. - BOARDS**

**Sec. 2-171. - Board of Review.**

(a) *Composition.* The Board of Review shall consist of the Village President, at least one Village Trustee and any three electors of the Village. Appointments to the Board of Review shall be made by the Village President, subject to confirmation by the Village Board. The elector members may be Village employees, elected officials and/or appointed officials. If a quorum of any other governmental body will be present as a result of the composition of the Board of Review, the Village Clerk will include a quorum notice in the notice of the Board of Review meeting. The Village Clerk shall attend the Board of Review meeting(s) to provide administrative support to the Board of Review, and shall maintain a record of the meetings and actions taken.

(b) *Duties.* The duties and functions of the Board of Review shall be as prescribed in Wis. Stats. §§ 70.46 and 70.47.

(c) *Compensation.* Compensation for Board of Review members shall be as established by resolution of the Village Board.

(d) *Meetings.* The Board of Review shall meet annually on the second Monday of May, or any day within the next 30 days, at the Windsor Municipal Building. Notice of such meeting shall be published pursuant to State law. The Board, through the Clerk, shall establish its meeting hours pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 70.47(3)(b). The Board may adjourn from day to day or from time to time, until such time as its business is completed, providing that adequate notice of each adjournment is so given.

(e) *Appeals.* To be heard by the Board of Review, an objection to an assessment is required to be in writing and filed with the Village Clerk no less than 48 hours before the first meeting of the Board of Review.
