INSTRUCTIONS

If you are the defendant in a case, a default judgment has been entered, and you wish to request that the court reconsider your case, you will first need to request the court to reopen your case. This form is designed to make it easier for you to make this request.

- PRINT who gave you the citation above the section labeled "Issuing Municipality". It will either be "Village of DeForest" or "Village of Windsor".
- PRINT your name above the section labeled "print your name".
- PRINT the citation number above the section labeled "Citation Number". The citation number can be found on any of the court correspondence that you have already received or you will find it in the upper right/left corner of your citation.
- Answer section 1 by entering the date that judgment was entered against you.
- Answer section 2 by simply checking one or more of the boxes
- Answer section 3. Section 3 is the reason why the court should reopen your case and why you think you will win if the court does reopen your case.

Upon receipt of your Motion to Reopen, the court will hold it for 5 days. Within the 5 days, the prosecution may file a written objection to the Motion. After 5 days, the court will review your Motion at its earliest convenience and provide you with a copy of its decision.

Prior to officially reopening the case, the court may require payment of a reopening fee. The charge is discretionary and is usually designed to reimburse the municipality for any expenses it has already incurred as a result of the original judgment being entered.

Other than the advice given here, the Clerk of Courts and the court are prohibited from giving legal advice. If you need further assistance, it is recommended that you seek the assistance of an attorney.
