

**Public Hearing on Proposed Boundary Agreement Amendment
Between the Village of Windsor and the Town of Vienna**

Notice is hereby given that the Village of Windsor (Windsor) and the Town of Vienna (Vienna) will each hold a public hearing to gather public input on a proposed boundary agreement amendment. Village of Windsor's public hearing is scheduled for April 18, 2019 at 5PM at the Windsor Municipal Building, located at 4084 Mueller Rd, DeForest, WI. Town of Vienna's public hearing is scheduled for April 16, 2019 at 7PM at the Vienna Town Hall, located at 7161 County Hwy I, DeForest, WI.

Windsor and Vienna participate in an intergovernmental agreement that, due to a recent boundary change between the Village of Windsor and Village of DeForest, more specific the removal of the ETJ South Area, the Windsor and Vienna intergovernmental agreement needs to be amended.

In general, the boundary agreement is intended to:

- Commit to certain provisions for future growth and development in a coordinated manner which minimizes the potential for disputes in the future and which protects and implements the respective land use plans of the two communities.
- Acknowledge that Windsor shall not, during the term of the Agreement, annex or otherwise attach to Windsor any lands within Vienna without the written consent of Vienna.
