AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 26 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES  
CONCERNING ADMINISTRATIVE CHARGE FOR FALSE ALARMS

WHEREAS, Village Staff recommends certain amendments to the Village of Windsor Code of Ordinances regarding administrative charges for false alarms; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board finds the proposed amendments to be in the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Windsor, Dane County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:


SECTION 1. Section 26-168(c) of the Windsor Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as stated in the attached Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. All other provisions of Code of Ordinances not specifically amended herein shall remain unmodified and in full force and effect.


SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.

## EXHIBIT A

Sec. 26-168. - Administrative charge for false alarms; costs for prosecution and collection of administrative charge.

(c) *Administrative charges imposed for false alarms.* There shall be an administrative charge applied and paid by any person who, while having a permissible and permitted alarm system at one or more locations, signals a false alarm, as set forth herein. Records of false alarms shall be maintained for false alarms to the Police Department. The Village Clerk shall be responsible for billing such costs and fees associated with the Police Department. Such administrative charges shall be billed to the owner of the property and, if unpaid for 30 days or more, shall be assessed against each property as a special charge for each false alarm made on a calendar year basis, as follows:

(1) *False alarm responded to by Police Department:*

- a. First two false alarms for a location: no charge;
- b. Third false alarm per location: set by fee schedule adopted by resolution of Village Board;
- c. Fourth false alarm per location: set by fee schedule adopted by resolution of Village Board;
- d. Fifth false alarm per location: set by fee schedule adopted by resolution of Village Board;
- e. Sixth and subsequent false alarm per location: set by fee schedule adopted by resolution of Village Board.
