

**VILLAGE OF WINDSOR
ORDINANCE 2019-33**

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SPEED LIMIT ON PORTAGE ROAD

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director and the Village of Windsor deputies recommend the reduction of the speed limit on Portage Road in the vicinity of Windsor Hill; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board considered the topography and housing density in the area, and the input of Village staff, law enforcement and members of the public residing in the area.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Windsor, Dane County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. The speed limit for the following section of highway within the Village is hereby established at 35 mph:

Portage Road from a point 500 feet south of the south property line of 6931 Portage Road to a point 470 feet north of the north property line of 7009 Portage Road

SECTION 2. The Public Works Director shall update the Official Traffic Map in accordance with section 1 above.

SECTION 3. The Public Works Director is directed and authorized to take all action necessary to implement this ordinance, including the installation of appropriate signage consistent with practices specified in the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

SECTION 4. All other provisions of Code of Ordinances not specifically amended herein shall remain unmodified and in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. The passage of this ordinance shall not affect any enforcement proceedings pending prior to the effective date hereof.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.

The above and foregoing Ordinance was duly adopted at a meeting of the Village Board of the Village of Windsor held on November 7, 2019, by a vote of 5 in favor and 0 opposed.
