

**VILLAGE OF WINDSOR
ORDINANCE 2019-34**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON MUELLER
ROAD**

WHEREAS, the Village Board recently adopted Ordinance 2019-21, prohibiting parking on Mueller Road from County Highway V to Portage Road.

WHEREAS, Village staff recommends amending the parking restrictions on Mueller Road to permit parking over the eastern portion of said area.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Windsor, Dane County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Parking of motor vehicles is hereby permitted on both sides of Mueller Road from a point 150 feet east of the centerline of the driveway serving the Windsor Public Works Facility and Recycling Center to Portage Road.

SECTION 2. Section 48-220(a)33 of the Windsor Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

(33) On either side of Mueller Road from County Highway V to a point 150 feet east of the centerline of the driveway serving the Windsor Recycling Center at 4035 Mueller Road.


SECTION 3. The Public Works Director is directed and authorized to take all action necessary to implement this ordinance, including the installation and removal of appropriate signage consistent with practices specified in the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices. The Public Works Director shall consider, and if reasonably possible implement, increasing the distance between the no parking signage on the portion of Mueller Road west of the Recycling Center.

SECTION 4. All other provisions of Code of Ordinances not specifically amended herein shall remain unmodified and in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.


