**WHEREAS**, the Village requested bids for the resurfacing project attached hereto as Exhibit A; and


**WHEREAS**, the bids were received and opened as per the Memorandum attached hereto as Exhibit B; and

***Subject: Village of Windsor - 2019 LRIP Road Maintenance and Resurfacing Program  
Bid/Proposal Summary***

Dear Mr. Clark:

Three bids for the Village of Windsor's 2019 LRIP Road Maintenance and Resurfacing Program project were opened on April 4, 2019. The 2019 LRIP Road Project bid included pulverizing and resurfacing of approximately 4,800 feet of Egge Road from a location just east of County Highway C to the Village of Windsor's boundary with Sun Prairie. A summary of the bid results are provided in this letter.

It should be also be noted that this Project will be partially reimbursed from a WisDOT Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP) that the Village applied for in 2018. The amount of the LRIP reimbursement was established at \$24,277.93 with a total estimated project cost of \$280,000.

The Village's 2019 LRIP Road Project was bid on a "unit price contract" basis with the contractor providing unit prices for estimated quantities of work items to determine a total estimated unit price Project bid amount. Five separate unit prices were obtained for the project based on an estimated quantity of work that we provided to complete the project scope. A complete listing of the bid items, estimated quantities, unit prices, and total unit price are identified in detail in the attached bid summary.

The three received unit price bid totals ranged from a low of \$196,556 to a high of \$225,805 as noted below.

Bidders were required to submit a 10% bid security, bidder qualifications, and their total bid amount for the schedule of unit prices. Tri-County Paving, Inc. submitted these documents. Note that Wolf



Paving and Excavating, Inc. only submitted a bid bond of 5%. If Wolf Paving and Excavating, Inc. had been the lowest responsible bidder, we would have, in consultation with Attorney Cole, either needed them to provide additional bid security or reject their bid.

Tri-County Paving, Inc. has successfully worked with Village of Windsor in the past with the most recent project being last year's Portage Road Resurfacing Project.

Based on the above, our recommendation is for the Village of Windsor to proceed with an award of contract to Tri-County Paving, Inc. for their total unit price bid of \$196,556.00.
