VILLAGE BOARD RESOLUTION 2019-78**

**CREATING A CENSUS 2020 COMPLETE COUNT COMMITTEE TO INCREASE
COMMUNITY AWARENESS AND PARTICIPATION IN THE 2020 CENSUS**

WHEREAS, the United States of America has performed a nationwide census every ten years since 1790, with the last census being in 2010; and

WHEREAS, population totals from the census determine the number of seats each state has in the United States House of Representatives and help determine how the State of Wisconsin draws state legislative districts; and

WHEREAS, the federal government distributes approximately \$675 billion in federal funding each year based in part on census data; and

WHEREAS, census data helps all levels of government forecast needs and plan programs and services; and

WHEREAS, local Complete Count Committees help increase overall awareness and rate of return by educating and motivating the public to participate in the Census; and

WHEREAS, at the September 20, 2018 Village Board meeting the Village Board approved the formation of a Complete Count Committee as a first step;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Village Board of the Village of Windsor as follows:

1. There is hereby established an ad hoc committee known as the Complete Count Committee ("Committee").
2. The Village President shall act as chairperson of the Committee.
3. The Village Clerk shall staff the Committee and act as liaison between the Village and the U.S. Census Bureau.
4. The Village President is authorized to select 4-8 committee members representing a cross section of community members who will utilize their local knowledge and expertise to reach out to all persons of our community.
5. The Committee shall be charged with informing Village residents concerning matters involving the 2020 federal census and facilitating a full, complete, and accurate response by Village residents.
6. The Committee shall sunset upon completion of its activities in 2020, as determined by the Village Board.

The above and foregoing resolution was duly adopted at a regular meeting of the Village Board of the Village of Windsor, Dane County, Wisconsin, on the 1st day of August, 2019, by a vote of 5 in favor and 0 opposed.
