VILLAGE BOARD RESOLUTION 2019-95**

**APPROVAL OF WINDSOR GARDENS PARADE OF HOMES
ROAD USE PERMIT APPLICATION**

WHEREAS, Don Tierney wishes to apply for the 2020 Parade of Homes for Windsor Gardens Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the Parade of Homes runs from June 6 – 21, 2020 (excluding Mondays and Tuesdays) with the hours of Wednesday through Friday, from 4 pm to 8 pm, and Saturday and Sunday from 11 am to 5 pm); and

WHEREAS, the Parade of Homes requires special parking and road closures during the event; and

WHEREAS, Don Tierney has completed a Road Use Permit Application, as per Windsor Code of Ordinances, requesting road closure and special parking during the Parade of Homes; and

WHEREAS, Don Tierney has filed a complete application which includes renderings of the affected roads, and will provide a Certificate of Insurance and the permit fee if selected for the Parade of Homes; and

WHEREAS, the Village Clerk has reviewed the application and supporting documentation, attached hereto as Exhibit A, and recommends approval.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Village Board of the Village of Windsor, that it hereby approves the issuance of a Road Use Permit to Don Tierney for Wagner's Vinyard Trail, permitting special parking and road closure during the Parade of Homes event being held June 6 – 21, 2020 (excluding Mondays and Tuesdays) with the hours of Wednesday through Friday, from 4 pm to 8 pm, and Saturday and Sunday from 11 am to 5 pm, as set forth in the permit application.

Issuance of the permit shall be conditioned upon the applicant: (1) agreeing to indemnify, defend, and hold the Village harmless in accordance with sec. 42-281(a) of the Code of Ordinances, in a form acceptable to the village attorney; and (2) furnishing the Village with a certificate of insurance listing the Village as an additional insured in accordance with sec. 42-281(b) of the Code of Ordinances, in a form and amount acceptable to the village zoning administrator.

The above and foregoing Resolution was duly adopted at a regular meeting of the Village Board of the Village of Windsor on August 27, 2019, by a vote of 5 in favor and 0 opposed.
