

**VILLAGE OF WINDSOR
BOARD RESOLUTION 2020-18**

**APPROVAL OF CLASS “B” FERMENTED MALT BEVERAGE AND “CLASS B”
INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSE FOR THE BAR NEXT DOOR**

WHEREAS, Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin State Statutes prohibits retail sales of alcohol beverages without an approved license granted and issued by a municipality; and

WHEREAS, the applicant has recently leased the former Topps Hideaway premise, which has previously surrendered its liquor licenses; and

WHEREAS, the applicant would like to open for business in April and would need a license from April 1, 2020 through June 30, 2020 (end of licensing year); and

WHEREAS, the applicant is renovating the premises, approval should be contingent upon inspections completed by the DeForest Windsor Fire Chief, Village of Windsor Building Inspector and Dane County Health Department; and

WHEREAS, the Village Clerk has completed background checks which disclosed no derogatory information precluding issuance; and

WHEREAS, the Village Clerk has published public notice of the application in accordance with section 125.04(3)(g) of the Wisconsin Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Village Clerk has reviewed all materials and recommends approval, contingent upon satisfactory inspections, of a Class “B” Fermented Malt Beverage and “Class B” Intoxicating Liquor License for Pegasus Restaurant Group doing business as The Bar Next Door, Peter J. Beeber, Agent.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Board of the Village of Windsor as follows:

1. Approval of a Class “B” Fermented Malt Beverage and “Class B” Intoxicating Liquor License for Pegasus Restaurant Group doing business as The Bar Next Door, Peter J. Beeber, Agent, for the premises described as follows:

The portion of 4506 Lake Circle Windsor, WI, leased to the applicant for conducting restaurant business, comprised of the bar, dining areas, coolers, and basement and halls used for storage

2. Issuance of the above licenses are conditioned upon inspection and approval of the premises by the DeForest Windsor Fire Chief, Village of Windsor Building Inspector and Dane County Health Department.

The above and foregoing resolution was duly adopted at a regular meeting of the Village Board of the Village of Windsor, Dane County, Wisconsin, on March 5, 2020, by a vote of 4 in favor and 0 opposed.
