

**VILLAGE OF WINDSOR
RESOLUTION 2020-56**

RESCINDING STATE OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, in December, 2019, a novel strain of coronavirus known as COVID-19 was detected, and COVID-19 has continued to spread throughout the world, including to the United States and the State of Wisconsin ("COVID-19 Pandemic"); and

WHEREAS, in response, on March 17, 2020, the Village President declared a state of emergency in the Village pursuant to section 323.11 of the Wisconsin Statutes; and

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2020, the Village Board passed Resolution 2020-28, ratifying the emergency declaration; and


WHEREAS, on March 19, 2020, the Village Board further passed Resolution 2020-29, granting the Village President and Village Administrator authority to take such actions to modify Village staff operations and programs from time to time, as they deem reasonably necessary.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Board that the state of emergency declared by order of the Village President on March 17, 2020, and ratified by the Village Board in Resolution 2020-28 is hereby rescinded.


BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED, the emergency powers granted in Resolution 2020-29 are hereby rescinded.
