**RECOGNIZING JUNE AS NATIONAL DAIRY MONTH**

**WHEREAS**, June Dairy Month started out as a way to distribute extra milk during the warm months of summer. The commemoration was established in 1937 by grocer organizations sponsoring "National Milk Month." By 1939, June became the official "Dairy Month" and is still celebrated today; and

**WHEREAS**, National Dairy Month is a great way to start the summer with nutrient-rich dairy foods. From calcium to potassium, dairy products like milk contain nine essential nutrients. Whether it's protein to help build and repair the muscle tissue of active bodies or vitamin A to help maintain healthy skin, dairy products are a natural nutrient powerhouse; and

**WHEREAS**, Wisconsin ranks #2 in milk production in the United States, generating 2.4 billion pounds of milk every month with the average dairy cow producing 6.3 gallons of milk per day and about 350,000 glasses of milk in a lifetime; and

**WHEREAS**, this annual observance pays homage to the state's deep-rooted dairy farming heritage and recognizes the hard work and dedication of Wisconsin's dairy farmers; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Windsor has a rich history of dairy farming; and


**WHEREAS**, dairy farming is largely a family tradition, as 98 percent of dairy farms in the United States are family owned and operated; and

**WHEREAS**, the dairy industry serves as a key driver in the national food system and supports the people of the United States both nutritionally and economically.


