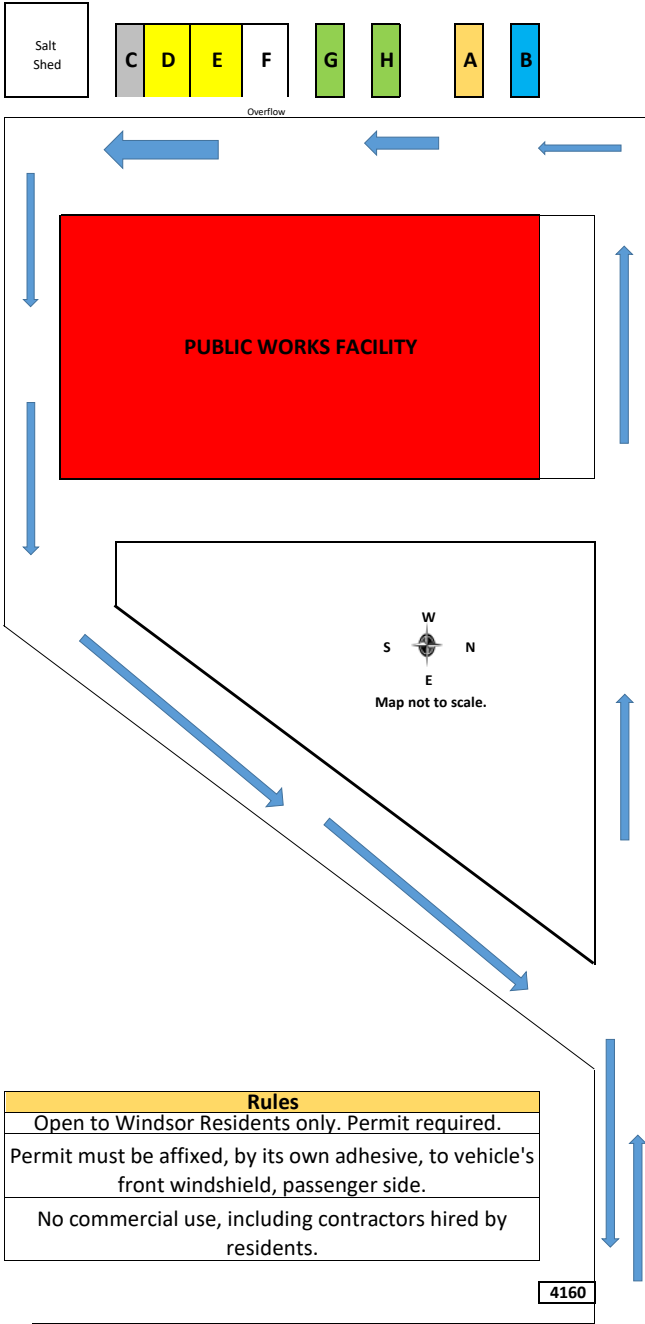

Rules
Open to Windsor Residents only. Permit required.
Permit must be affixed, by its own adhesive, to vehicle's front windshield, passenger side.
No commercial use, including contractors hired by residents.

(A) CARDBOARD	Must be broken down - flat

(B) METALS BIN	Aluminum (siding, gutters, lawn furniture, storm window frame)
	Appliances without refrigerant (oven, dishwasher, washer, dryer, water heater)
	Brass (pipes, etc.)
	Copper (pipes, guttering, strip wiring, construction materials, etc.)
	Microwaves
	Steel (motors, tools, etc.)

(C) OIL & TIRES (NO RIMS)	Auto Tire: \$3 each
	Semi-Truck Tire: \$20 each
	Rear Tractor Tire: \$50 each
	Motor Oil only - We DO NOT accept motor oil filters.

(D & E) YARD WASTE	Leafy vegetation that composts in a short time
	Grass
	Leaves
	Garden Waste

(G & H) BULK WASTE BIN	Bathtubs/Sinks
	Cabinets
	Drywall
	Carpet/Padding
	Small Amounts of Construction Debris (NO concrete)
	Siding
	Doors (no glass)
	Chairs/Sofas
	Tables
	Exercise Equipment
	Mattress/Box Springs
Toilets	
Lawnmowers & Snow blowers (gas and oil must be removed)	
Grills (propane/gas tanks not accepted)

	Curbside recyclables (cans, plastics, glass, paper, etc.)
