ROAD WORK

Road work season is already well under way and this year there are a number of road work projects.

2020 Completed Road Work Projects:

- Pulverizing and overlay of Egge Road between Portage Road and Hwy C, Heron Way, Partridge Road, Leonard Road, and E. Leonard Road was completed this May.

2020 Road Work Projects to be Completed:

- Reconstruction of Hwy DM, Clinton Road and part of Willow Road in Morrisonville. This also includes new water main, new storm sewer, and sanitary sewer repairs. One of the goals of this project is to improve the storm water drainage and help reduce the flooding in the area after a heavy rain event. The project started late May and is partially funded by Dane County.
- Crack sealing and chip sealing of Gray Road between Hwy 51 and Portage Road, Combs Court, and all the roads in the Millstone Heights subdivision is scheduled for late May.

COVID-19 Requires DeForest Windsor Fire & EMS to Adapt to Changes

The coronavirus has changed the way everyone goes about their daily lives. DeForest Windsor Fire & EMS is no exception. We are a combination department that relies heavily on paid on-call personnel and is supplemented by a small career staff during the day. In 2019, the department responded to 1499 emergency calls. With that type of call volume, our station is staffed 24/7 for both fire and EMS related emergencies.

Social distancing is a challenge that we work through daily to keep our members and patients as safe as possible. The station has four rooms with 3 beds in each that we use for sleeping quarters. To help with social distancing, we needed to restrict the number of members staying at the station overnight. Utilizing the space we have, we moved beds into training rooms and offices to help accommodate those that needed to stay.

As much as we like to see visitors, we needed to lock down the department from non-essential people. Members are required to fill out a questionnaire prior to each shift along with a temperature reading to help prevent possible exposure to other members and patients. Early on in the pandemic, we had a member test positive for COVID-19. That member was quarantined at home and was able to return to work in a few weeks.

CLEANING and DISINFECTING is a never ending job at the department. We have members coming and going on a daily basis. That means cleaning and disinfecting rooms, bathrooms, offices, and common areas numerous times a day. We would like to thank the high school for lending us a powerful UV light used for disinfecting rooms.

We want to thank the community for donating gloves, masks, soap, hand sanitizer, and gowns to the department as our supply, and availability to these items, was in serious jeopardy. DeForest Windsor Fire & EMS is grateful to have two strong communities along with supportive businesses that provide us with the necessary items to safely serve the community. - Paul Jacobsen, Fire Captain
