ORDINANCE 2020-02**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND
SECTION 2-2 OF THE
WINDSOR CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING POSTING AND PUBLICATION**

WHEREAS, Village Staff recommends certain amendments to the Village of Windsor Code of Ordinances regarding public notice of all meetings for governmental bodies;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Windsor, Dane County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:


SECTION 1. Section 2-2 of the Windsor Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as stated in the attached Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. All other provisions of Code of Ordinances not specifically amended herein shall remain unmodified and in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.

The above and foregoing Ordinance was duly adopted at a meeting of the Village Board of the Village of Windsor held on April 2, 2020 by a vote of 5 in favor and 0 opposed.

EXHIBIT A

Sec. 2-2. - Legal posting and publication; designation of official newspaper.

Method of notice and posting: The Village shall use posting pursuant to State law.

Publication: When publication is required by state law or when publication is directed by the Village Board, the official newspaper shall be the DeForest Times-Tribune.

PREVIOUSLY:

Sec. 2-2. - Legal posting and publication; designation of official newspaper.

Method of notice and posting: The Village shall use posting pursuant to State law ~~as its primary means of giving notice.~~

~~*When notice shall be posted:* Notices shall be posted before the act or event requiring notice and no later than the time specified for the first newspaper publication.~~

~~*Where notice shall be posted:* The notice must be posted in at least three public places likely to give notice to persons affected or must be posted in at least one public place likely to give notice to persons affected and placed electronically on an Internet site maintained by the municipality. By its own motion, the Village Board shall determine the location for the public places used for notices.~~

Publication: When publication is required by state law or when publication is directed by the Village Board, the official newspaper shall be the DeForest Times-Tribune.
